You are being provided with the GreekKeys 2008 keyboard and fonts package as a student of ancient Greek in a college or university program that has paid for an extension to a departmental license for this software package. Please note the conditions under which you are granted use of this package. If you are unwilling to abide by these conditions, do not install this software on your computer.

1. You are granted permission to use this software during the course of your degree studies. Upon completion of your degree or upon other final separation from the program that provided you with this software, you are expected to remove this software from your computer, or to obtain your own licensed individual copy if you wish to continue to use GreekKeys 2008 keyboards and fonts.
2. You may share this software with other students enrolled in ancient Greek courses at the same institution, but not with anyone else, and you should provide others with the entire package, unaltered, and with a copy of this sheet.
3. You may not post this software package or parts of it to any public web site or file-sharing service.

1. Your department or instructor will lend you a CD or USB flash drive from which you should copy the folder “GreekKeysUnicode2008” to your own computer before returning the source media to your department or instructor.
